An art installation of coloured sponge titled "Let's take a ride on the magic carpet" by the academic artist Ana Ivanovska will open Tuesday evening in Skopje-based Cultural Information Centre.

The exhibit will run through November 15.

Ana Ivanovska (born in 1982 in Skopje) graduated at the Faculty of Fine Arts in Skopje, Macedonia (2006) at the painting department and course of conservation and restoration. In 2007 she finishes the Pedagogical Department at the Faculty of Fine Arts in Skopje and in 2011 the Postgraduate studies at the same faculty.

She is a member of Association of Artists of Macedonia (DLUM) and one of the founders of the art group Art I.N.S.T.I.T.U.T. and the alternative art exhibition space in Skopje, 2009. In 2012 she became one of the seven members of female group 'MOMI' (LADIES).

Her work has been presented in various group exhibitions, performances, art colonies, workshops and artist residencies in Macedonia and abroad in Netherlands, Denmark, France, New York (USA), Russia, Mongolia, China, Austria, Italy, Serbia, Montenegro, Kosovo, Croatia and Bulgaria.
